



October half term holiday club at Brownmead Academy (B34 6SS) for children from all schools (COVID-19 regulations in place)

We are pleased to be able to take bookings for the Multi-Sports and Activity camp at Brownmead Academy over October half term 2020. The guidance from the Government confirms that Out of School providers are able to open for school holidays. Open to:

Multi-Sports and Activity camp: All children in school years 1 – 6. This setting will comprise of two bubbles, Blue and Yellow. Yellow bubble will be children from years 1, 2 and 3, and Blue bubble years 4, 5 and 6. Please ensure you book for the correct year group at the time of booking.

Times:

9am – 3:30 each day

Cost:

£14 per day from 9am - 3:30 and £10.50 for siblings

Block booking per week from 9am - 3:30, £60 and £45 for siblings

How will we be keeping children safe under current guidance?

- Numbers will be capped at 30 per day for the Multi-Sports and Activity camp.
- Group sizes will be no bigger than 15 per day in line with Government guidance and children will remain in their bubble with their staff member all day. Children will sit in the same hall with the other bubble at lunch, but this will be on separate tables and adequately spaced out.
- Each bubble will have their own equipment and this will not be shared across bubbles.
- Equipment will be cleaned at the end of each day.
- Sign in and sign out will take place outside and will be contactless. No adults other than staff will be allowed to enter the venue.

- Children and staff will be required to wear clean clothes each day.
- High traffic areas such as door handles and benches will be cleaned throughout the day.
- Children will only be allowed to bring their packed lunch and drinks bottle (both clearly labelled) into camp each day.
- Games and activities will take place outside where possible.
- Where activities take place inside, adequate space will be given to ensure it is safe.
- Our camp ran for 6 weeks of the summer holidays at Brownmead Academy very successfully under the current guidance and we will be operating with the same proven measures in place.

Social distancing:

For the Multi-Sports and Activity camp, the Yellow and Blue will be kept separate throughout the day. This will be either in separate sides of the hall, or specific areas of the field and playground. Parents will be required to wait 2 metres apart when arriving to drop off or collect children from the camp.

'Bubbles' and PPE:

We are unable to keep the same bubble of children each day due to the flexibility of parents being able to book from as little as one day, up to a full week. We are able to keep the bubbles of children consistent on each given day under current guidance which states 'consistent as far as possible'. For example, all children in years 1, 2 and 3 will be in the Yellow bubble whenever they are booked in throughout the week. We have a clear track and trace in place with our online booking portal. We are able to manage the environment effectively without the use of PPE for staff, which is in line with Government guidance. If a child becomes unwell and is displaying symptoms of COVID-19, staff will have to isolate that child from others and use PPE to protect themselves.

What happens if a child has symptoms?

If this is noticed by parents before the child comes to camp they must stay at home and the parents must tell head office immediately. If this is noticed during camp time, the child will be isolated immediately and staff will wear PPE whilst supporting the child. The child's parents will be notified immediately and the child will need to be collected as soon as is possible. It is possible that the whole of the child's bubble will then need to self-isolate, as will the member of staff in that group. Parents of all the children in the group will be notified.

What will the days look like?

We have been running our Multi-Sports and Activity camps since 2011 and the days will follow our proven routines of active fun combined with themed games and competitions. Children will be playing lots of running around games, as well as challenges that our amazing, creative staff facilitate such as 'Who Wants To Be A Millionaire' and 'The Cube'. Our staff all work within schools delivering PE and School Sport so are familiar with the new way of working to ensure safety for all. We aim to ensure all children have fun, make new friends and try something new!
